Studio 10 Dance Wear – This year we will offer basic dance items at the studio. We will keep some items in stock, while others can be ordered and picked-up at the studio in 3 days. Since this is a new adventure, we will stock limited items in the beginning. Once we get a better idea of what colors and sizes are most popular, we will have much more inventory available at the studio.

Which Classes Should I Register For?

Current/Returning Students should remain in the same level of class for a minimum of 2 years unless notified by instructor (tap classes minimum of 3 years). Example: Sally should take Jazz 3 for two full years before advancing to level 4.

All classes progress yearly regardless of level, based on the group's ability.

Beginning / Level 1 classes = Dancers age 2nd and 3rd grade (beginner dancer or has taken less than 2 years of Level 1)

Beginning / Level 2 classes = Dancers age 2nd and 3rd grade (taken Level 1 classes for minimum of 1 year)

Intermediate / Level 3 classes = Dancers ages 4th and 5th

Intermediate / Level 4 classes = Dancers age 6th and 7th grade

Advanced / Level 5 classes = Dancers 7th grade and up

Advanced / Level 6 classes = Previously enrolled in Level 6 OR must have

teacher's approval

Jazz 5 and 6 = Must be enrolled in a Ballet class

Hip Hop 5 and 6 = Must be enrolled in technique based class (Ballet or Jazz).

Wiggles and Giggles = Preschool ages 3-4 (Dancers must be able to be without their parents for the duration of the class.) - Combination of ballet, tap, jazz, and hip hop. 45 minutes

Adaptive Dance = Children with exceptionalities and special needs will thrive in this group class with individual support. Led by a Pediatric Occupational Therapist and Kinesiologist, children will be given opportunities to explore movement through music with close supervision. Focus will be on gaining body awareness, balance, and self-confidence while expressing dance through creative rhythmic and sensory experiences. Sophie will accommodate behavioral, sensory, joint, and safety precautions. 1 hour **There is no charge for this class. 8 week session ending on October 24th.**

Adult = All ages welcome, from beginner to advanced. Dance moms dance for FREE if your dancer takes more than one class weekly, or if you have multiple dancers! Otherwise, the cost is \$8.00 per class. No registration fee required. 1 hour

Thursday – Adult Jazz / Hip Hop – 8:00 pm – Cassie / Jeron

Dance Technique = Dance Technique is designed for the dancer preparing to try out for their school dance team. Focus will be on leaps, turns, and technique. Must be able to complete clean double turn. Levels 5 and 6 only. 1 hour

Saturday – 11:00 am – Sam

Barre 10 = Ages teen to adult. A low impact (no jumping) fitness class focusing on toning abdominals, thighs, hips and glutes. Strengthening and stretching while learning ballet basics. Wear pants or leggings (no shorts) and socks. Equipment needed: yoga mat or towel. Hand weights 3 – 8 lbs. Dance moms dance for FREE if your dancer takes more than one class weekly, or if you have multiple dancers! Otherwise, the cost is \$8.00 per class. No registration fee required. 45 minutes

PAYMENT OPTIONS

At Studio 10, all prices are pro-rated over the 8-month session, and remain the same regardless of variability in total number of classes offered each month. The full Fall/Spring session is 8 months (September – April). We offer three payment options to allow your family flexibility. The first option is to pay monthly (due the 1st of every month). Next is to make 2 equal payments for the full amount, one each semester (September and January 1st). Finally, you can choose to pay for the full year by September 30th. The yearly payment option saves you 10%. Remember that fewer payments equals fewer invoices and late fees, plus you receive the discount!

Family Discounts – Class fees are on a “per student” basis. If a family has more than one dancer, apply a family discount of 10% (take 10% off of each dancer’s total)! If you pay the yearly fee up front, you will receive a 12% discount (an additional 2% to what is listed in the chart in the YEARLY column).

REGISTRATION FEE

\$25 Registration Fee per dancer (\$20 for each additional sibling)

If completed registration is received by September 10th, a t-shirt is guaranteed for the parade.

After September 10th, we cannot guarantee a parade t-shirt.

Fee is required annually with the registration packet and 1st payment to reserve class space for your student. Registration is not considered complete and class space is not reserved until all fees are paid.

REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

You will receive confirmation via email once your registration is complete and a space has been reserved for your child.

If your registration is incomplete, the requested class is full, or if for any other reason your registration is not accepted, we will contact you via phone or email.

Registration fees and class fees are non-refundable.

Wiggles / Giggles, Pre-K Combo, Combo, Adv. Combo, and Jr. Hip Hop / Cheer Classes

All classes at Studio 10 are closed. No one, including parents, is allowed to view the class during normal weekly class. Special Parent Watch Weeks are scheduled to allow you to see the progress your child is making. We run our classes similar to a school setting, in which dancers must be able to be without their parents for the full 45 minute class time. We have found that this policy provides the best environment for your child to learn effectively. Also, especially in our Tiny 10 studio, there simply isn't room for more than the dance instructor and the students.

To eliminate all distractions and interruptions, parents are asked to leave the building during their child's class. Please do not wait in the foyer or in an open studio.

Safety first! All students are required to stay inside the studio until they are picked up. Curbside parking is available outside the studio and the city hall parking lot is available across the street. We will have curbside drop offs starting in November for the Tiny 10 studio classes.

No strollers, dirty or wet shoes, high heels, or food / drinks are allowed on the raised "Marley" dance floors. We ask that these be kept on the carpeted areas only.

Please respect the classes that are in session by not arriving more than 5 minutes before your child's class is dismissed.

When your child's class is dismissed, the studio doors will be opened. All dancers are kept inside the studio until a parent / guardian arrives to pick them up. Please do not enter the studio early unless you have made early departure arrangements with the instructor.

All shoes and bags must be labeled with your child's name prior to their first class. Studio 10 is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

Hair must be pulled back and secured for all dance / cheer classes. Extremely long hair should be in a bun.

ALL students are required to wear a leotard to class.

CHEER and **HIP HOP** classes wear a **leotard** with **black bootie shorts** and **tights**. Must also wear **clean tennis shoes** that are only worn during the class (no street shoes).

WIGGLES / GIGGLES, COMBO, and ADV. COMBO students wear **black tap shoes** and **pink ballet shoes** (available at Payless Shoes or in the Studio 10 Boutique Shop). **Leotards** and **tights** should be worn. Skirts are optional but should be attached to the leotard. Knot and cut all ballet strings on ballet shoes.

Policies and Guidelines

The following Studio 10 rules and procedures have been established so that your child can receive the safest, most enjoyable, quality dance education possible.

Prorated Payment Structure

- All fees remain the same regardless of long (5 class weeks) or short (2 class weeks) months, and regardless of absences or holidays.
- All fees are pro-rated.
- We build two “flex” weeks into the studio schedule payment plan. This allows flexibility if needed for snow days or instructor sick days.

Fees and Withdrawal

- Payments are due by the 1st of the month. This policy remains the same on holidays. Payments not received by the 10th of the month are **automatically charged a \$20.00 late fee**. A secured payment box is located inside the studio foyer, and a secured mailbox is located outside the building, or you can mail your payments. Online payments are coming soon also!
- A \$25.00 service fee, in addition to any applicable late fees, is assessed with any returned check which is not paid by the bank on which it is drawn, for reasons such as non-sufficient funds, refer to maker, missing signature, etc.
- The registration fee, class fees, recital fees, and costume fees are **non-refundable**.
- Should a student need to withdraw from any or all classes at any time during the Fall/Spring 2014-2015 session, written notice must be given 2 weeks in advance. Without written notice, the student is still considered active and charges are still incurred.
- Accounts must be kept in good standing for a dancer to continue participating in weekly classes, receive costumes, and participate in the Spring Recital.
- Students with an outstanding balance over 30 days are not allowed to participate in weekly classes until the balance is paid in full.
- All outstanding payments over 60 days are handled by a collection agency and / or lawyer.

Drop-off and Pick-up

- Students should arrive for their class in proper attire no earlier than 10 minutes prior to class time and be picked up no later than 10 minutes after the class is over. Studio 10 is not responsible for students before and after class time. Students not picked up within 10 minutes of their class dismissal will be charged a \$15.00 fee.
- Please respect classes that are in session by not arriving more than 5 minutes before your child’s class is dismissed.
- For your child’s safety, please come inside the studio to drop-off and pick-up all students. Students are not to leave the studio without a parent or guardian.
- When your child’s class is dismissed, the studio doors will be opened. Please do not enter the studio early unless you have made early departure arrangements with the instructor.

Cancellation / Missed Classes

- We **ALWAYS** follow the Liberty School District when canceling classes for inclement weather. An email or text will also be sent if classes are canceled. If in doubt, call the studio for a recording notifying students of cancellations.
- For the health of other students and teachers, we ask that you do not bring your child to dance if they are sick. If a student misses a class, the instructor will inform them of a comparable class that can be taken during the next month to make up the missed class.

Parent Watch Week

- Studio 10 runs classes similar to a school environment - All classes are closed to the public and viewing is not allowed. All dancers must be able to be without their parents for the duration of the class. We have found that this policy provides the best environment for your child to learn.
- To eliminate all distractions and interruptions, parents are asked to leave the building during their child’s class. Please don’t wait in the foyer or an open studio.
- Parent Watch Weeks are **every other month** (specific dates to be announced). During Parent Watch Week classes, parents are encouraged to stay and view the entire class to see the progress your child is making.
- During the month of April, only Wiggles / Giggles, Combo, Pre-K Combo, and Jr. classes

- will have Parent Watch Week.
- Tiny 10 and Saturday dancers will have Saturday Parent Watch Days (specific dates to be announced).
- Classes will dismiss 10 minutes early on Parent Watch Weeks (excluding Tiny 10 classes).
- **Absolutely no viewing by anyone, including parents, is allowed at other times.**

Dress Code

- Proper dance/cheer attire is required for all classes. Students not adhering to the dress code will not participate in class.
- **ALL students (with the exception of boys classes) are required to wear a leotard to class.**
- **BALLET** and **POINTE** must have leotards, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a bun. Skirts are optional.
- **MODERN** students wear leotards and pink footless / convertible tights only. No shoes.
- **TAP / TECHNIQUE / JAZZ** classes wear leotards, tights (black, pink, or tan), black bootie shorts, and tan tap and / or tan jazz shoes (required). No t-shirts or pants. Tan tap shoes for Tap Levels 1 – 3. **For Wiggles / Giggles, Combo, and Adv. Combo, see information below.**
- **CHEER** and **HIP HOP** classes wear a leotard with black bootie shorts and tights. Must also wear clean tennis shoes that are only worn during the class (no street shoes).
- **BOYS** classes wear a t-shirt or tank top with shorts and clean tennis shoes (no street shoes).
- **WIGGLES / GIGGLES, COMBO, and ADV. COMBO** students wear black tap shoes and pink ballet shoes (available at Payless Shoes or in the Studio 10 Dance Wear Shop). Leotards and tights should be worn. Skirts should be attached. Knot and cut all ballet strings on ballet shoes.
- Hair must be pulled back and secured for all dance / cheer classes. Extremely long hair should be in a bun.
- All dance shoes and bags must be labeled with the dancer's name prior to their first class.
- Studio 10 is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

Recital

- The annual Spring Recital is in late April / early May – more specific information TBA. Performances are Friday at 7:00 pm, and Saturday at 11:00 am, 2:00 pm, and 7:00 pm, with mandatory dress rehearsals the week of recital. The Spring Recital is optional, but most students do participate.
- A \$35.00 per family recital fee is required on February 1, 2015.
- Due to lengthy production time, recital costumes are ordered in December. A \$75.00 per dancer costume deposit is due November 1, 2014.
- All costumes are approximately \$75.00 or less.
- A parent must sign the costume order signature board inside the studio by November 1, 2014 in order for their child to participate in recital.
- A detailed Preliminary Recital Packet is distributed in October, and a Finalized Recital Packet is distributed in January.

Facility

- All three studios are equipped with professional raised “Marley” flooring.
- No street shoes, high heels or food / drinks are allowed on the dance floors.
- All strollers must be kept on the carpeted area only.
- Studio 10 is a **NUT FREE** facility. Due to students with extreme allergies – no peanut snacks (PB&J, peanuts, etc.) are allowed inside the studio.
- Students are welcome to bring food or drinks and keep them with their bags, but must pick-up after themselves. No delivery food is allowed.

Injuries

- Parents, legal guardians of minors, students, and visitors waive the right to any legal action for any injury sustained on Studio 10, Inc. property resulting from normal dance and cheer activity or any other activity conducted by the students before, during, or after class time.

Consent/Release

- I hereby waive and release Studio 10, Inc. and its officers, agents, volunteers, and employees from all acts or omissions resulting in any physical injuries, medical treatment, or other damages to myself or any minors of whom I am parent or legal guardian, resulting from participation in Studio 10, Inc. programs. I further waive and release Studio 10, Inc. and its officers, agents, volunteers, and employees from any damages sustained by the aforementioned or any guests of the aforementioned as a result of any condition, act, omission,

or accident on or at 210 E. Kansas St., Liberty, Missouri, or any other premises upon which any activity related to Studio 10, Inc. takes place.
