Which Classes Should I Register For?

Wiggles and Giggles - Ages 3-4

Combo, - Ages 5-6 Kindergarten and First graders

Level Classes - Current/Returning Students should remain in the same level of class for a **minimum of 2 years** (except level 1) unless notified by instructor. Example: Susie should take Jazz 3 for two full years before advancing to Jazz 4. **All classes progress yearly regardless of level, based on the group's ability.**

Level 1 classes = Dancers aged 2nd and 3rd grade (beginning dancers and dancers moving up from combo level classes)

Level 2 classes = Dancers aged 2nd and 3rd grade (taken Level 1 classes for 1 year)

Level 3 classes = Dancers aged 4th and 5th grade

Level 4 classes = Dancers aged 5th and 6th grade

Level 5 classes = Dancers aged 6th, 7th, and 8th grade

Level 6 classes = Previously enrolled in Level 6 OR must have teacher's approval.

All Modern, All Pointe and All In-10-sive= Must be enrolled in, *and actively attending*, a Ballet class.

Our "Competitive-Lite" Company offers dancers the chance to experience the benefits of extra training, team performance opportunities, and a supportive company environment. All while keeping things affordable, balanced, and classy.

This program is perfect for dancers who:

- ✓ Want more stage time and focused training
- ✓ Value teamwork, commitment, and growth in a positive environment holding to our core values and beliefs. Music and Costumes will be age appropriate. No bedazzled bikinis ;-)
- ✓ Aren't ready for the full demands of a high-pressure competition schedule
- ✓ This WILL NOT effect our current recreational program — this adds on, not replaces!

We're building a team where encouragement comes first, progress is celebrated, and the joy of dance stays at the heart of it all.

Competition Team Class Requirements

2026/27 Competition Season

At our studio, we believe dancers can be successful while also participating in other activities. We encourage our dancers to explore their interests, and we believe children should have the opportunity to participate in one or more sports if they choose. To help accommodate busy family schedules, we offer two conditioning class options during the week for dancers who have Saturday sports or other commitments. This flexibility allows dancers to continue building the strength and conditioning needed for competition while balancing other extracurricular activities.

To ensure every dancer is technically prepared and successful throughout the competition season, all competition team members are required to enroll in specific classes based on their competition level. Consistent attendance in these classes is expected.

Cost expectations based on ONE dance competition. Addition comp fees if we, as a group, decide to do a second local competition.

FEES

Company Fees - \$100 per month + weekly required classes

Includes: Saturday Classes, weekly conditioning classes and group dance choreography for competitions. Does not include week-day classes or solos.

Costume estimates: All group costumes will be under \$100 per costume. Most competitive studios only buy custom made costumes ranging from \$250-\$350 per costume. We will try to find creative ways to make our costumes unique without breaking the bank for something that is only worn for 2 minutes. Last year we found clearance solo costumes for as little as \$25 (we even won some “best costume awards” with costumes that came from Shein and Amazon!)

Competition Entry Fee - \$55/Dancer + \$25 registration fee/dancer (We can decide how many routines we want to enter. One for sure and possibly two per age group). Entry Fee will be due two months prior to competition.

OPTIONAL FEES

Solos -Choreography one-time fee \$150 includes choreography, music editing, and weekly 30 minute practices. Costumes will be left up to parents (we can advise and order) Spend as little or as much as you want. Several larger competitive studios will sell their used costumes on FB market place or through sales.

Duet and Trio - Choreography one-time fee \$200 (split \$100 per dancer) includes choreography, music editing, and weekly 30 minute practices. Costumes will be left up to parents (we can advise and order) Spend as little or as much as you want. Several larger competitive studios will sell their used costumes on FB market place or through sales.

Solo Entry Fee - \$165 + \$25 Comp reg fee

Duet/Trio Entry Fee - \$70/Dancer + \$25 Comp reg fee

Team warm ups: Based on what the girls decide we will have a matching team warm- up. This will be an optional add on. Last year we ordered Lulu dupes on amazon and had embroidered.

Class Descriptions and Attire

Ballet = SEE NEW BALLET DRESS CODE BELOW

Contemporary 5/6 = Leotard, tights, leggings or biker shorts. Bare feet and Pink Ballet shoes.

Combo = Preschool already age 5-6, Kindergarten and 1st grade - Combination of ballet, tap, jazz, and hip hop. Thursday Combo will be Ballet, Jazz, hip Hop and Cheer only (no tap). SEE links below for visuals or to purchase from Amazon.

Any color leotard and tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes. If worn, skirts should be attached to leotard. Knot and cut all strings on ballet shoes.

In10sive = A dance technique class that is designed for the dancer preparing to try out for their school dance team. Focus will be on leaps, turns, and flexibility. **For Levels 5 and 6.** In the Advanced class, the dancer must be proficient in grand jetes, center leaps, solid double pirouette, 2 eight counts of turns in a la seconde (7 secondes and a double pirouette out of it.) *Any color leotard, tights, biker shorts or leggings.* Must be enrolled in, **and actively attending**, a Ballet class to attend an In10Sive class NO EXCEPTIONS.

Jazz = *Any color leotard, tan tights or biker shorts or leggings, tan jazz shoes*

Dancers in Level 5 one 6 ONLY can wear biker shorts (mid-thigh length) and tank top. No more than 2 inches of midriff showing.

Hip Hop 5 and 6 = *Any color leotard or tank top, biker shorts, leggings or sweats, tan jazz shoes or clean sneakers (no street shoes AKA dirty sneakers)*

Modern = Must be enrolled in, **and actively attending**, a Ballet class (Level of Ballet class should directly correlate with level of Modern class). Class focuses on Graham and Horton Technique. Convertible tights. *No Shoes.*

Pointe = Must be enrolled in, **and actively attending**, a Ballet class Level 4 or higher. Ages 11 and up. **Need teacher's approval. Text Cassie [816-918-3747](tel:816-918-3747). Will need at least two to three pairs of shoes during the season.**

Tap = *Any leotard, tights or leggings, tan tap shoes – slip-on boots or lace up only – NO taps with ties, Velcro or buckles.*

Wiggles and Giggles = Preschool ages 3-4 (Dancers must be able to be without parents for the duration of the class, also potty trained or in a pull-up) - Combination of ballet, creative movement, tap, jazz, and hip hop. Thursday class will be ballet and jazz only (no tap). *Any color leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes. If worn, skirts should be attached to leotard. Knot and cut all strings on ballet shoes.*

Ballet Dress Code

We are updating our ballet dress code to bring back consistency and create a more uniform look in class. Over time, our current dress code has gone a bit rogue (we love the personality, but it's time to tidy things up!).

Dancers will need:

- A solid black leotard (any style is fine). Dancers may still wear colored leotards, but all dancers will need a black leotard
- Pink convertible tights
- A level-specific skirt (colors will be assigned based on dancer level)

This new system will help teachers with class organization and create a polished, professional feel in the studio. Plus the skirts will be used in a possible Christmas performance, so it's a win-win!

I've linked some cheap options. These are just visual options. You may purchase any skirt you want in that levels' color. Must be short or high-low. Can be a wrap skirt or a pull on skirt (prefer pull on for levels 1-3). No biker shorts or athletic shorts in ballet.

WIGGLES AND GIGGLES/COMBO INFORMATION

All classes at Studio 10 are closed. No one, including parents, is allowed to view the class during normal weekly class. Special Parent Watch Week are scheduled to allow you to see the progress your child is making - SEE CALENDAR.

We run our classes similar to a school setting, in which dancers must be able to be without their parents for the full class time. We have found that this policy provides the best environment for your child to learn effectively. Also, especially in our Tiny 10 studios, there simply isn't room for more than the dance instructor and the students. If there are any separation anxieties we always make exceptions until the child is comfortable, as long as it doesn't have a negative effect on the other dancers.

Parents may run errands, wait in car or quietly wait in foyer.

Safety first! All students are required to stay inside the studio until they are picked up. Curbside parking is available outside the studio and the city hall parking lot is available across the street.

No strollers, dirty or wet shoes, high heels, or food / drinks are allowed on the raised "Marley" dance floors. We ask that these be kept on the carpeted areas only.

Please respect the classes that are in session by not arriving more than 5 minutes before your child's class is dismissed.

When your child's class is dismissed, the studio doors will be opened. All dancers are kept inside the studio until a parent / guardian arrives to pick them up. Please do not enter the studio early unless you have made early departure arrangements with the instructor.

All shoes and bags must be labeled with your child's name prior to their first class. Studio 10 is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

Hair must be pulled back and secured for all dance / cheer classes.

ALL Female students are required to wear a leotard to class.

WIGGLES / GIGGLES and COMBO students wear any color leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes. Skirts should be attached. Knot and cut all ballet strings on ballet shoes.

Policies and Guidelines

The following Studio 10 rules and procedures have been established so that your child can receive the safest, most enjoyable, quality dance education possible.

Prorated Payment Structure

- All fees remain the same regardless of long (5 classes) or short (2 classes) months, and regardless of absences or holidays.
- All fees are pro-rated.
- We build two “flex” weeks into the studio schedule payment plan. This allows flexibility if needed for snow days or instructor sick days.

Fees and Withdrawal

- Payments are due by the 1st of the month. This policy remains the same on holidays. Payments not received by the 10th of the month are **automatically charged a \$20.00 late fee**. A secured payment box is located inside the studio foyer, and a mail slot is located outside the building. You can also mail your payments or pay online.
- A \$25.00 service fee, in addition to any applicable late fees, is assessed with any returned check which is not paid by the bank on which it is drawn, for reasons such as non-sufficient funds, refer to maker, missing signature, etc.
- **The registration fee, class fees, recital fees, and costume fees are non-refundable.**
- Should a student need to withdraw from any or all classes at any time during the Fall/Spring 2026-2027 session, written notice must be given 2 weeks in advance. You can send an email to janell@studio10dancecheer.com. Without written notice, the student is still considered active, and charges are still incurred.
- Accounts must be kept in good standing for a dancer to continue participating in weekly classes, receive costumes, and participate in the Recital.
- Students with an outstanding balance over 30 days are not allowed to participate in weekly classes until the balance is paid in full.
- All outstanding payments over 60 days are handled by a collection agency and / or lawyer.

Drop-off and Pick-up

- Students should arrive for their class in proper attire no earlier than 10 minutes prior to class time and be picked up no later than 10 minutes after the class is over. Studio 10 is not responsible for students before and after class time. Students not picked up within 10 minutes of their class dismissal will be charged a \$15.00 fee.
- Please respect classes that are in session by not arriving more than 5 minutes before your child's class is dismissed.
- For your child's safety, please come inside the studio to drop-off and pick-up all students. Students are not to leave the studio without a parent or guardian.
- When your child's class is dismissed, the studio doors will be opened. Please do not enter the studio early unless you have made early departure arrangements with the instructor.

Cancellation / Missed Classes

- We **ALWAYS** follow the Liberty School District when canceling classes for inclement weather. An email will also be sent if classes are canceled. A decision will be made by 2:00 pm about evening classes (if Liberty hasn't already canceled evening activities by that time). If in doubt, check our website, Instagram or Facebook page for cancellation updates.
- For the health of other students and teachers, we ask that you do not bring your child to dance if they are sick. If a student misses a class, the instructor will inform them of a comparable class that can be taken during the next month to make up the missed class.

Parent Watch Week for Wiggles and Combo

Studio 10 runs classes similar to a school environment - All classes are closed to the public and viewing is not allowed. All dancers must be able to be without their parents for the duration of the class. We have found that this policy provides the best environment for your child to learn.

- To eliminate all distractions and interruptions, parents are asked to leave the building during their child's class or wait quietly in foyer. No chairs due to high traffic area
- Parent Watch Week November 23rd
- **Absolutely no viewing by anyone, including parents, is allowed at other times.**

Dress Code

- Proper dance attire is required for all classes. Students not adhering to the dress code will not participate in class.
- **ALL female students are required to wear a leotard to class.**
- **BALLET** must have any color leotard (preferably black, pink convertible or footed tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a bun or ponytail. Ballet skirts
- **POINTE** must have any color leotard, pink convertible or footed tights, pointe shoes, hair in a bun or ponytail. skirts are optional.
- **MODERN** students wear any color leotard (preferably black), pink convertible tights, no shoes,
- **TAP** classes wear any color leotard, tights, spandex shorts or leggings, tan tap shoes – slip-on boots or lace up only – NO taps with ties, Velcro or buckles.
- **JAZZ** classes wear any color leotard (preferably black), tan tights, spandex shorts or leggings, and tan jazz shoes. ***Only Jazz 5 and 6 dancers can wear biker shorts (mid-thigh length) and tank top. No more than 2 inches of midriff showing.***
- **HIP HOP** students wear any color leotard, mid thigh spandex shorts, leggings or sweats, tan jazz shoes or clean sneakers (no street shoes).
- **In-10-sive** students wear any color leotard, tights, mid thigh spandex shorts or leggings.
- **BOYS** wear a t-shirt or tank top with shorts and clean tennis shoes (no street shoes) or appropriate class footwear.
- **WIGGLES / GIGGLES and COMBO** students wear any color leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes. Skirts should be attached. Knot and cut all ballet strings on ballet shoes.
- Hair must be pulled back and secured for all dance / cheer classes. Extremely long hair should be in a ponytail
- All dance shoes and bags must be labeled with the dancer's name prior to their first class.
- Studio 10 is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

Recital

- The annual Recital will be on June 3,4 and 5 with rehearsals during the day and performances in the evening – more specific information will be released closer to the event. The Recital is optional, but most students do participate.
- A \$60 *per family* recital fee is required on March 1, 2027.
- Due to lengthy production time, recital costumes are ordered in December and January. A \$80 costume deposit for the 1st class costume, plus a \$25 deposit for each additional costume is due December 1, 2026.
- We do our best to keep the cost of all costumes at approximately \$80 or less.
- A Finalized Recital Packet is distributed in the spring.

Facility

- All four studios are equipped with professional raised “Marley” flooring.
- No street shoes, high heels or food / drinks are allowed on the dance floors.
- All strollers must be kept on the carpeted area only.
- No dogs in studio
- Studio 10 is a **NUT FREE** facility. Due to students with extreme allergies -no peanut snacks (PB&J, peanuts, etc.) are allowed inside the studio.
- Students are welcome to bring food or drinks and keep them with their bags, but must pick-up after themselves. No delivery food is allowed.

Injuries

- Parents, legal guardians of minors, students, and visitors waive the right to any legal action for any injury sustained on Studio 10, Inc. property resulting from normal dance and cheer activity or any other activity conducted by the students before, during, or after class time.

Consent/Release

- I hereby waive and release Studio 10, Inc. and its officers, agents, volunteers, and employees from all acts or omissions resulting in any physical injuries, medical treatment, or other damages to myself or any minors of whom I am parent or legal guardian, resulting from participation in Studio 10, Inc. programs. I further waive and release Studio 10, Inc. and its officers, agents, volunteers, and employees from any damages sustained by the aforementioned or any guests of the aforementioned as a result of any condition, act, omission, or accident on or at 210 E. Kansas St., Liberty, Missouri, or any other premises upon which any activity related to Studio 10, Inc. takes place.

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
